Community Updates

Wheatfield Parking: We understand that parking issues on Wheatfield Drive have been a source of frustration for many residents. We would like to assure the residents that the Board has consistently taken proactive steps over the past few years to address the parking situation with the county.

Many residence are not aware that the roads in the Farm are County owned and maintained. As such, the Board has been continuously in contact with County officials to address the ongoing parking issues. In the past week, we have spoken to two police lieutenants who stated they are currently investigating ways to alleviate the parking challenges. We have been informed by the police department that there are 6 traffic cops and 54 schools all in Horry County who are currently facing the same parking issues.

We will continue to collaborate closely with the County and will keep the community updated on any progress or information that may arise.

Wheatfield Sidewalk: We would like to provide an update on the sidewalk issues along Wheatfield Drive. These concerns were reported to the county back in July, and at that time, we were given a three week repair schedule.

Unfortunately the arrival of Hurricane Debby has caused delays in the county's repair efforts, pushing may projects behind schedule. Last week, we reached out for an update, and the County informed us that they hope to have the sidewalk issue repaired within the next two weeks.



Pool Closings: Both pools will close for the season on October 15th.

Labor Day Update from Waste Industries:

Friendly Reminder – Our offices will be closed in observance of Labor Day, but our *trucks will be running as normal*. With that said, we do have a lot more trash, traffic, and wait times at the landfill during a holiday which does slow us down so some routes may start earlier in the day or may be serviced later in the day.
